Навчально-методичне видання призначене для проведення занять з англійської мови зі студентами І курсу факультету міжнародних відносин при вивченні дисципліни "Іноземна мова", програмою якої передбачена робота над засвоєнням граматичних навичок.

Основна **мета** навчально-методичного видання – розвинути, удосконалити й систематизувати навички вживання узгодження часів і пасивного стану в англійській мові.

Навчально-методичне видання складається з двох розділів та містить такі граматичні структури: *Sequence of tenses; Passive voice*. Усі завдання відповідають вимогам сучасної методики викладання іноземної мови.
